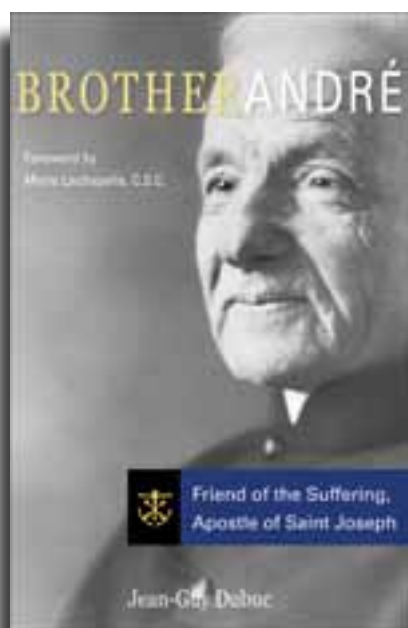


Brother André to Become 11th Canadian Saint

Known popularly as the “miracle man of Montreal,” Brother André Bessette, C.S.C.- an unassuming porter who became legendary for his ministry to the sick and needy of Montreal- was formally recognized on February 19 by the Vatican as one of six candidates who will be canonized a saint later this year.

Brother André will be the 11th Canadian saint, the first since Saint Marguerite d’Youville was canonized in 1990.
